History of Clovia:

- ◆ Founded in 1931 by a small group of women to provide an economical and supportive living environment.
- ◆ Alpha of Clovia is the first of five Chapters.
- ◆ Clovia is a national organization, presently including Alpha at KSU and the Beta Chapter on the University of Minnesota, St. Paul campus.

Mission of Clovia:

- ◆ To provide a sisterhood for former 4-H women to come together in a living situation, which promotes the life skills originally learned as part of their 4-H experience.

- ◆ Oversees the physical and emotional well being of Clovia and it's women

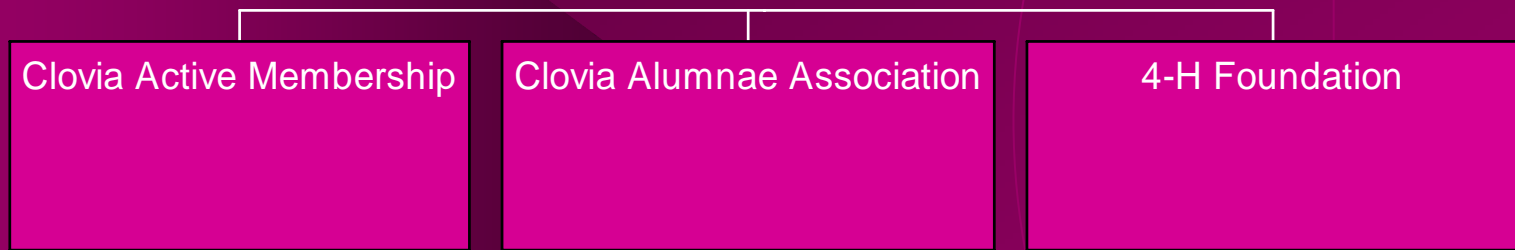
Alpha of Clovia Alumnae Association
