- Follow all Alpha of Clovia policies, procedures, and guidelines
- Live in and reside overnight at the Alpha of Clovia House during the specified contract period
- Work with House Business Managers to plan weekly menus with consideration for various dietary restrictions
- Order food and supplies with the assistance of the House Business Managers
- Keep accurate written records of all food, supplies, and materials ordered and received
- Oversee the daily operations of the House and provide weekly reports to the designated representative of the Alpha of Clovia Alumnae Association
- Oversee routine maintenance of the House with the assistance of the House Manager. Notify Alumnae House Maintenance Committee of any needed repairs and make recommendations for capital improvements
- Supervise repairs and maintenance services to insure quality of materials and workmanship. Maintain written records of all repairs and recommendations
- In collaboration with the House Leadership Team work to insure that all health and safety procedures are followed and that equipment (smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, carbon monoxide monitors, furnace filters, fire sprinkler system) is in good working order
